ACTION PLAN OF IQAC OF GOVT T. ROMANA COLLEGE AND THE OUTCOME:

The College has been constantly functioning and working in order to improve the quality and standard of the institution. One of the main actions planned out for this academic session was to set up a Career Guidance and Counselling Cell within the college to give career awareness and guidance to the students for their career options. Accordingly, the College has applied available grant to the UGC, New Delhi and fortunately, the UGC has allocated 3.00 lakhs for the purpose during the XIth Plan (2007-2012) and is still under process though the grant has not received yet from UGC.

The College has organised Remedial English class for the students in order to improve their written and spoken skills in English, as proposed in the previous academic session. The remedial class was taken up by the department of English. Besides, the departmental and inter-departmental seminars were also conducted successfully and the Library has also been greatly enriched by procuring a number of new books and subscribing journals.

Each of the academic departments conducted a number of class test, giving more assignments and tutorial seminar during the last academic session. This has been a kind of preparation for making internal evaluations as a part of semester system to be introduced by the University.

Subsequently, the extension activities proposed such as blood donation camps, plantation of new trees, cleanliness drives, health check up and others were also carried out successfully within the College during the reporting period.

18. COMMUNITY SERVICES:

The College organised various numbers of social work in the form of cleanliness drive during the academic session of 2009-2010 in which the students as well as faculty members and the establishment staff are engaged in cleaning the college campus as well as the locality.

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of the college organised a special work camp in Republic Veng, Vaivakawn, Zamuang village and Chanmary West during this period where waiting shed, pavilion and public urinal were constructed. Subsequently, a public urinal was also constructed at Remand Home, Durtlang.

The College also successfully organised career awareness campaign and sanitation campaign, in the form of NSS and IQAC during this period.

A Blood Donation Camp was also successfully organised by NSS Unit of the College on October 6, 2009 at College Hall in which 73 units of blood was collected which is to be used by Aizawl Civil Hospital to the needy patients.

19. TEACHERS AND OFFICERS NEWLY RECRUITED:

Ms. Malsawmkimi was temporarily appointed as part-time lecturer in the Department of Economics for three months during September to December, 2009

20. TEACHING - NON TEACHING STAFF RATIO:

There are 34 regular Lecturers and 17 non-teaching staff including the Principal. Thus, the teaching-non teaching ratio is 2: 1 (Two: One)

21. IMPROVEMENTS IN THE LIBRARY SERVICES:

The College Library has seen a tremendous growth and development both in the collection of books, documents and library materials during the last academic session (2009-2010). The Library maintains different sections such as Reader section, Periodicals and Journal, Circulation, Document, Archives cum Museum, Back volume and circulation counter. Each of the sections are now improved and enriched in collection of books, journals etc. during the reporting period.

The Library Computer has been linked with Local Area Network (LAN) with other college computer for installation of library software 'SOUL' and the process is being started.

The Library is manned by a qualified Librarian and other technical staff. The Librarian Mr S. Lalnunpuia has submitted his M Phil Dissertation entitled 'Impact of Public Libraries on Mizo Society in Mizoram with special references to Aizawl District' to the Global Open University, New Delhi during the reporting period and result is awaited.

Besides, the Library is maintained and monitored by the Library Improvement Committee chaired by the Principal which makes suggestion and provides library facilities such as purchasing books, furniture, equipments etc. for the development of Library.

The Principal took the responsibility of keeping the questionnaires as confidential documents and as took necessary action in accordance within the result of the assessment made by the students

24. UNIT COST OF EDUCATION:

The unit cost of education for students during the academic session of 2009-2010 is Rs. 51,674/- approximately.

25. COMPUTERIZATION OF ADMINISTRATION AND THE PROCESS OF ADMISSIONS AND EXAMINATION RESULT, ISSUE OF CERTIFICATES:

The administration of T.Romana College is fully computerized. The clerical staff members have carried out computerization of administration and the process of admission. The annual examination and issue of Certificates however is handled by Mizoram University.

26. INCREASE IN INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES:

There have been quite a few developments in the infrastructural facilities during this period. Some of the major developments were:

- a) The existing Library has been shifted to a new room to accommodate more students and visitors as the old one was very limited in space for keeping books and furniture.
- b) A number of benches and tables have been procured and six computer tables are made for Computer Learning Centre.
- c) The College took various initiatives for new college site and fruitful results have been awaited.

Besides, the University Grant Commission (UGC), New Delhi has sanctioned the following grants to our College during the period:

- a) Received Rs. 3.5 lakhs for purchasing Books and Journals. A number of books and journals have been purchased and subscribed respectively.
- b) Received Rs. 50,000.00 under 'one time grant' for improving infrastructural facilities.

- c) Approved and sanction amounting to Rs. 72.00 lakhs for '*Development Grants and Merged scheme Grants*' during XIth Plan (2007-2012) period to our Colleges.

27. TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION:

The College website www.trcollege.net is well maintained and updated. The College authority has entrusted Mr. H Lalnunmawia, Lecturer in the Department of Economics to administer and monitor the website. Since all the college computers have been linked with Local Area Network, all faculty members and students have access to the internet.

28. COMPUTER AND INTERNET ACCESS AND TRAINING TO TEACHERS AND STUDENTS:

The College has started Computer Learning Centre during the reporting period under the Career Oriented scheme of University Grant Commission (UGC) in which Rs. 7.00 lakhs have been sanctioned for the scheme. Accordingly, the centre has offered three month's Certificate Course in Computer Applications with specialization in Desktop Publishing Technology (DTP) for the students.

The Course Syllabus, as per guidelines of the UGC, is prepared keeping in view the subject specific academic needs and market requirements, with the help of the subject experts. The Course syllabus has been submitted to the College Development Council of Mizoram University and is presently awaiting approval from the Academic Council. At Present, two courses have been completed in which 22 students successfully completed their course.

Computer and Internet access has been made available for both students and faculty members. The Computer Learning Centre also offered basic training course in computer to the faculty member.

29. FINANCIAL AID TO STUDENTS:

All the students of this college who are belonging to the scheduled tribes have been awarded post-Matric tribal scholarship during 2009-2010. In addition to this, the students who are economically disadvantaged are either given full or partial concession of fees. Sportspersons with outstanding records are also completely exempted from paying fees.

30. SUPPORT FROM THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION AND ITS ACTIVITIES:

The Alumni Association of the College have given their support in all the activities of the College and encouraged the staff and the students in all their activities. They have constantly given advices, feedback to the college which enriched the ethos of the institution.

31. SUPPORT FROM THE PARENT-TEACHERS ASSOCIATION AND ITS ACTIVITIES:

To improve the quality of education of the College there is a good and friendly environment in the Parent-Teacher Association of T.Romana College.

32. HEALTH SERVICES:

The IQAC has constituted Medical Cell to check and maintain the student's health and arrangements have been made for giving health check up, awareness campaign etc. The Medical Cell organised a number of training and awareness campaign during the academic session of 2009-2010, as the follows:

- a) The Medical Cell organised HIV/AIDS awareness campaign within the College campus in collaboration with the newly form Red Ribbon Club of the College.
- b) Organised 'first aid basic training' for the students and maintain first aid kit in the college.
- c) A number of students had been sent to participate in 'Peer Educator' training organised by the Mizoram State AIDS Control Society (MSACS) to spread awareness and to help student's fellow about HIV/AIDS.
- d) Organised free health check up on January 19, 2010 at the college.

33. PERFORMANCE IN SPORTS ACTIVITIES:

The college actively participated in the Mizoram University Sports Meet (inter-college sports) organised by Mizoram University during September 7-11, 2009 at Aizawl in which the college stood 5th (fifth) position in the overall result with 1(one) gold medal, 1(one) silver medal and 1(one) bronze medal.

Some of our College staff also participated in the Inter-Departmental Sports, 2009 during September 22-25, 2009 at Aizawl in which two of our College staff bagged medal as follows:

i) Ms Lalchhuanawmi, LDC and partner bagged gold medal in Table Tennis mixed doubles.

ii) Mrs Carolin Laldinsangi, Department of History, Ms Lalchhuanawmi LDC and partner bagged gold medal in Women's team.

34. INCENTIVES TO OUTSTANDING SPORTSPERSONS:

The College has felicitated the students who won medals for the college in the University Sports. The Gold medallists were given, as proposed by the Felicitation Committee, a sum of Rs 1,000/-, Silver medallists were given 700/- and Bronze medallists were given a sum of Rs 500/- each. Accordingly, the College has felicitated the College women's Hockey Team, men's Volleyball team and men's Basketball team who won Gold medal, Silver medal and Bronze medal respectively in the last Mizoram University Sports Meet, 2009. In addition to the amount sanctioned, the faculty member has donated a sum of money which added to the total amount sanctioned. Therefore, a Rs. 4,200 /- cash incentive was awarded to the winning team. A special function was organised in which these awards are distributed by the Principal of the college.

36. ACTIVITIES OF THE GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING CELL:

The Guidance and Counseling Cell organized a Career Guidance Programme in co-ordination with the NSS unit of the College. The cell invited Mr. Zothansanga LLB as the resource person along with him some of the Lecturers of the College gave informative and educative lectures to the students.

1. COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE:

The college is projected to acquire a new building of its own and aim in finding various sources to finance the college infrastructure. As mentioned earlier, the College has to received Rs. 72.00 lakhs from University Grants Commission(UGC), New Delhi during the current Plan period(i.e.2007-2012) in which some amount have been allocated for infrastructural developments. Therefore, a number of development works under the realm of College infrastructure will be made during the next academic session.

2. IMPROVEMENT OF LIBRARY:

The college knowing the importance of a well equipped library shall try its level best in trying to procure as much books, journals, e-books etc as possible from various sources.

3. TRAINING FOR TEACHERS:

To improve the proficiency as teachers the college plans to call experts in the field from the College of Teachers Training, Aizawl.

4. STRENGTHENING OF IQAC:

To strengthen IQAC, the College has applied to UGC for 'Establishment and Monitoring of Internal Quality Assurance Cell in Higher Education Institutions (HEIS)'. If this is granted the College will receive 3lakhs, with this amount of money the College plans to set up a new IQAC Office which is equipped with computer, internet facilities and the College also plans to give honorarium to the coordinator.

5. EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:

a) Career Oriented Course:

The College has applied for introduction of another Certificate Course under Career oriented scheme to the UGC in addition to the existing

course i.e. Certificate Course in Computer Application. If so, the College will open one certificate course during the next academic session.

b) Seminar / Symposiums:

The college has received some amounts from University Grant Commission, North Eastern Region Office (UGC-NERO), Guwahati for organising Seminar during the next academic session. Accordingly, one day State Level Seminar is scheduled to be organising on the topic of 'Mizo Poetry' during May, 2010 at Aizawl.

c) Publication of Book: The College is intending to publish the research papers presented in the Seminar on the topic of 'Society, Economy and Political History of the Mizos' organised by the College during 2009, in book form

d) Blood Donation: Blood donation camps will again be organized during the next academic session where willing students and faculty members will donate blood for those in need.

e) Career Guidance and Counselling: Knowing the importance of Career Guidance and Counselling, the College plan to call experts in this field who will be able to help the students in directing their career options and life.

f) Cleanliness: Cleanliness drive will also be organized atleast twice a year. It will not only ensure the cleanliness of the college campus but also the area in which the college campus is situated.

g) Plantation: The College unit of National Service Scheme (NSS) has a plantation site in Sihhmui area, situated along the Lengpui Airport road. Being a custodian of this plantation site, fencing and clearing of weeds is one of the important activities of the unit every year.
